
We can't wait to welcome you to Prince's to enjoy some of the finest links golf on the Kent Coast.

We want to make sure you have the best experience possible, so we have highlighted some useful information upon your arrival.




Journey to the Clubhouse

Upon arrival in Sandwich, follow the signs to Prince's Golf Club, which will take you through the Sandwich Bay estate (guests of Prince's do not need to pay the toll) and then down past the coast – a beautiful drive to the clubhouse.



Arrival at the Clubhouse


The clubhouse has two entrances, with the main entrance at the rear by the car park with another entrance opposite the putting green and short game area.



Check In

On arrival, you can go straight to our pro shop to check in for your tee time and to pick up anything you might need for the round.

We also have a restaurant at the Clubhouse for food prior to or after golf!



Tee Time

Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to ensure that you are able to play at your reserved time.



Practice Facilities

We have a fantastic Short Game area located beside the clubhouse, with a large putting green and chipping greens emulating the undulations commonly found out on the course.



Driving Range

The driving range, just a short walk from the clubhouse, has recently benefitted from the installation of world-leading driving range technology, Toptracer – the perfect place for a relaxed warm up or performance driven practice session. Range Balls to be purchased from the Pro Shop.

Short Game Area

Our multi-faceted short-game area blends into the run-off from the 9th green on the Himalayas and provides the perfect pre-game opportunity to fine tune your skills before you tee off.

The Lodge

If you are booked in to stay with us, you will have noticed the Lodge as you were making your way towards the clubhouse. Just a short journey back up the road, our members of staff will be there to welcome you with a warm and friendly smile.

Dining

What time do the restaurants open and where can I find the menu?

An early breakfast can be arranged upon request. Please let us know in advance on any time changes

Do you cater for food allergies, intolerances, and diets?

We have a variety of breakfast items on our menu and are able to accommodate specific diet requirements. If you have a food allergy or are vegan/vegetarian, please let us know prior to arrival and we can ensure we cater to you.

Do you serve lunch?

Yes, lunch is available and advisable to pre book.

Do we have to book for dinner?

Dinner should be booked with our reception team, and we advise, if you are a larger group, to book in advance for your preferred time.

Is there anywhere to just have a drink?

The Bar in the Lodge serves a range of drinks, for all occasions – with the terrace area open in the summer months!

Do you have any specialty drinks?

You can try our Prince's Gin, a locally produced premium gin.

Is Sky Sports available in the bar?

Yes, Sky Sports is available in the Lodge bar. For any specific TV requests, please ask the bar staff and they'll be able to accommodate.

What other facilities does the Lodge have?

We have a pool/ snooker room in the bar, and cues are available from Reception. There is a £5.00 deposit to pay.

I have an electric car; do you have any charging points?

Yes, there are two charging points at the Lodge and two at the clubhouse.

What time do the restaurants open and where can I find the menu?

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Do you have a half-way hut?

All three nines loop back to our Spike Bar, where guests can grab a quick snack and drink. Be on the lookout for our famous sausage rolls!

Do you have visitor locker rooms?

Our locker rooms are available to all guests, and lockers are available upon request. Showers are available, and we provide complimentary towels and shower gel if required.

Do you serve Sunday Lunches?

We do serve a Sunday Carvery, with either a one, two or three course meal available. Please make sure to get in contact ahead of time to pre book! Due to this, we do then only serve a limited sandwich menu on Sundays at the Clubhouse.

What time does the clubhouse close?

If you do have a late tee time, please check on the day the seasonal closing times to ensure items do not get locked in. If this does happen, please call reception on 01304 611118.

Do you cater for electric cars?

Yes, we have two car charging points at the Clubhouse!

Pro Shop/Golf Course

Am I able to hire anything on my visit?

Our hire items include electric trolleys, pull trollies and buggies. Please note that we only have a limited number of buggies and we require these to be booked in advance.

What is the number for the Pro Shop?

The Pro Shop number is 01304 695569.

We have a corporate/society day at the club, what should we expect?

Prizes can be bought in the Pro Shop from our extensive range of items available, and we can set up a prize table on request.

If you would like nearest the pins or longest drive markers, please ensure you arrange this with our team in advance.

Score card management is available for large groups, for a small price per person and this is to be arranged in advance. We can also set up registration tables for groups, so please talk to our team on what you might require for the day.

What 18 holes will I get to play?

We have three loops of nine holes at Prince's; the Himalayas, Shore and Dunes. Upon booking, our team will let you know which 18-hole combination you will play.

Do I have to have a handicap to play the course?

No handicap is required, but please note that guests with a high handicap may find the course quite challenging.

Will I be playing on temporary greens in the winter?

No, we do not operate temporary greens in the winter.

Do you have course guides?

Course guides are included within the green fee and our stay and play packages, and will be complimentary upon check in.

Do you have a range available to use?

Yes, range balls are available at the Pro Shop. Our range also has industry leading range technology Toptracer available for all our guests to utilise.
