Please note that from 20th December 2020 the golf course will remain open for 2 ball play, Clubhouse will only be offering a takeaway food & beverage service the toilets will be open. the Lodge will remain closed

Update from 20/12/2020

According to England Golf guidelines Prince's is in a Tier 4 area and as such the guidelines are as follows:

Golf courses in Tier 4 areas can remain open for play in the following formats:

- Individual play
- Two-balls from same or different households/bubbles
- Three or fourballs involving people from the same household/bubble

“The All-Party Parliamentary Group for Golf is happy to confirm that golf courses will be able to remain open when the new Tier 4 restrictions become effective in parts of England from 06:00 GMT on Sunday 20th December.

“In Tier 4 areas, golf courses can remain open for individuals playing with members of their own household or support bubble, or with one person from another household.

“As usual, social distancing is to be observed and all necessary steps are to be taken to ensure a COVID-19 secure environment.

“Under Tier 4 restrictions, non-essential retail – including Pro Shops and golf retailers – must close. Click and Collect will, however, be permitted.

“Outdoor coaching will be allowed on an individual basis or for multiple members of the same household or support bubble. Indoor coaching will be not be permitted.

Health and Safety:

- All staff members have undertaken the High Field Online Training Covid-19 business course to enhance their knowledge of the relevant guidelines, procedures, and cleaning processes required
- We have successfully completed the Visit Britain 'Good To Go' Covid-19 accreditation
- Please make use of the hand sanitizing stations.
- Face coverings must be worn in all indoor areas. There are some exemptions to wearing face coverings including children under the age of 11 and those with certain disabilities.
- Please always respect social distancing measures.
- High-touch areas, such as bathrooms, lift buttons and remote controls, are disinfected, and cleaned with a higher frequency
- Please be advised that due to the new cleaning regime that service may take a little longer than expected.

Golf

- The Clubhouse will be open from 8.00am to 4.00pm
- The Pro Shop will be open for click & collect from 8.00am to 12.00pm
- Please check in at the external door to the new Pro Shop for your tee time
- The nets and short game area will be open. The Driving Range will be closed.
- All hire items are cleaned and sanitised daily.
- As all rakes have been removed from the course you can move your ball 6 inches no nearer the hole. Please attempt to smooth over any footprints when exiting the bunker.
- Flags must always remain in the hole.
- Payment will be taken via your members levy or credit/debit cards. We are unable to take cash currently.
- Changing rooms will remain closed but toilets are open. Access to Members' own lockers is permitted.

Takeaway Food & Beverage

- We will be offering a takeaway hot & cold drinks and takeaway food service from the Spike Bar from 8.00am to 4.00pm
- Payment will be via member's card or debit/ credit card, we cannot accept cash payments.
- Please do not congregate in either the Spike Bar or directly outside.
- We are not able to offer any indoor seating areas.
