Dress Code

We request that you refrain from wearing denim in the Clubhouse. Smart denim is permitted (but not ripped denim) in The Lodge.

Electricity

Each room uses UK220 volt sockets and each bathroom is equipped with a 120-volt shaving point located to the bottom right-hand side of the mirror. Electrical adaptors can be provided from reception, we will require a refundable £5 deposit.

Ironing

All rooms have both an iron and ironing board provided. Apartments all have an iron in the cupboard under the sink and an ironing board behind the door into the apartment.

Keys

Please leave your room key at the reception desk when you leave the hotel. If your keys stop working at any stage during your stay, please contact reception and we will issue a new key. The key card also triggers the lights in the rooms and is also for identifications purposes at the bar/restaurant and will be required for room charges.

Lift

Children under the age of 12 are not permitted to use the lift without adult supervision. In case of fire do not use the lift, stairs only!

Light System

When you enter your room, there is a device on the wall near to the door. Place your room card in the card reader to activate the light control. When you leave don't forget to take the room card with you.

Green Policies

At Prince's and The Lodge at Prince's we take conserving the environment very seriously. Throughout the hotel, clubhouse and golf course we have measures in place to help reduce our carbon footprint.

As a matter of environmental concern, we kindly request that you use water and electricity responsibly and reuse towels whenever possible to help conserve the environment:

Bed Linen

Linen is changed on the 3rd day of your stay.

Electricity

We have energy saving devices in all the rooms. Once the card is removed from the slot the lights will time out. All lightbulbs are energy efficient across the site.

Local Suppliers

Where possible local suppliers are used particularly for meat, fish, fruit and vegetable produce in both the Lodge and the clubhouse.

Recycling

All waste is separated into separate types and sent away to be recycled.

Towels

Please hang up towels you wish to reuse. Please leave any towels you would like replaced in the bath/shower.

Waste Water

All waste water is treated on site and returned to the 37,000 m³ reservoir for use as irrigation on the course. The reservoir is tested for water quality annually to ensure that it is compliant and is safe for use in sprinkler irrigation.
